LETTERMEN'S CLUB

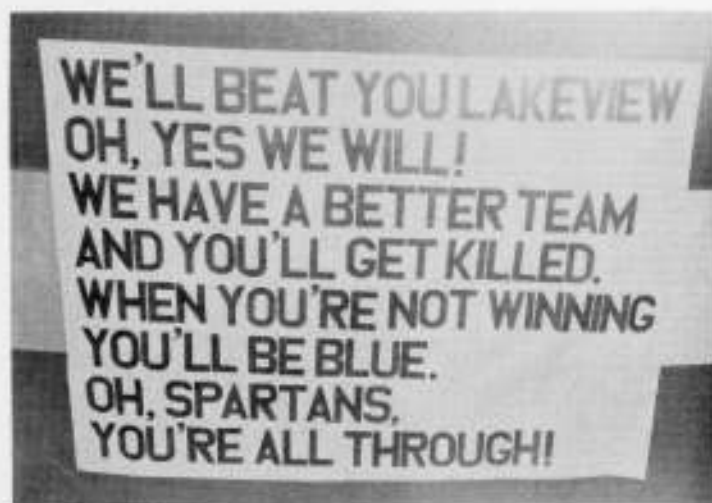

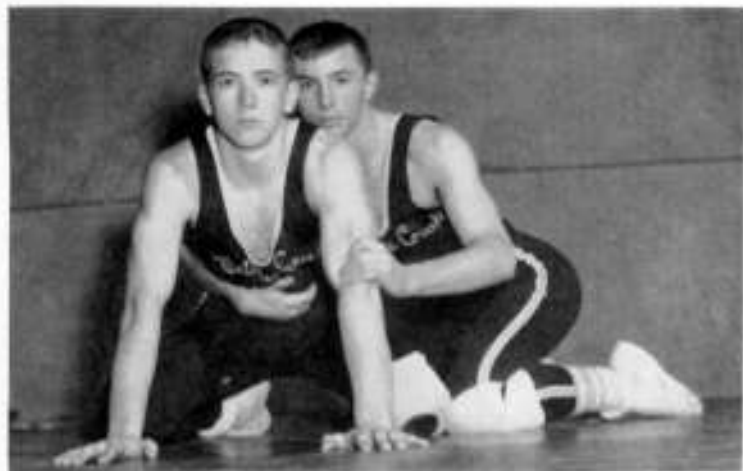
WRESTLING

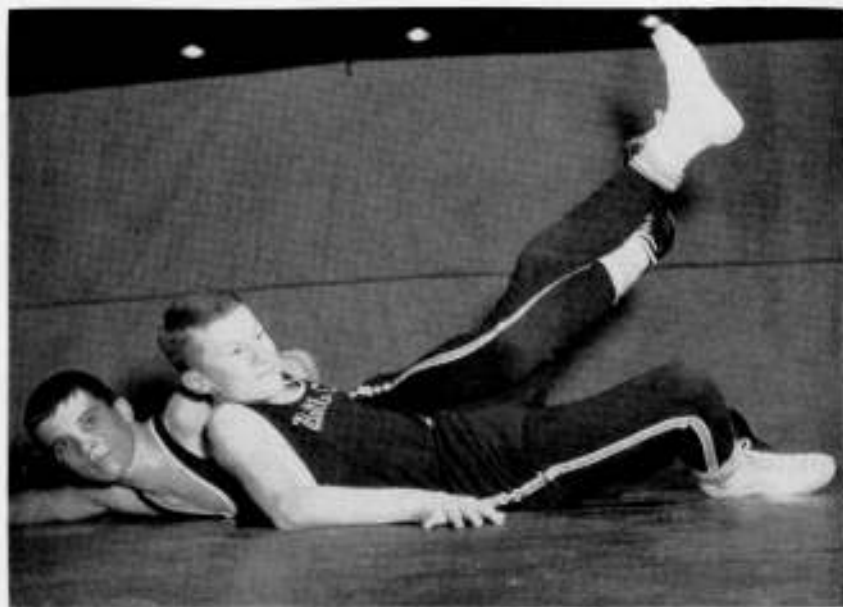

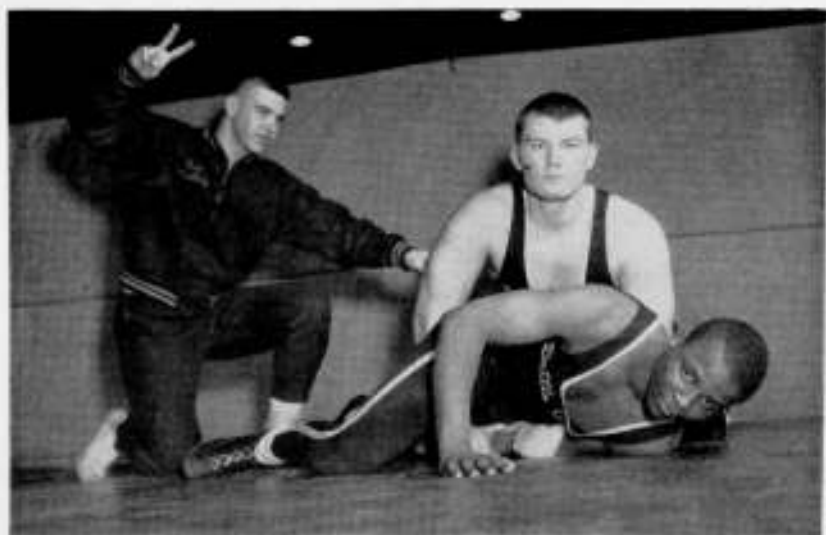
