Girls' Pep Club Supports Bearcat Activities

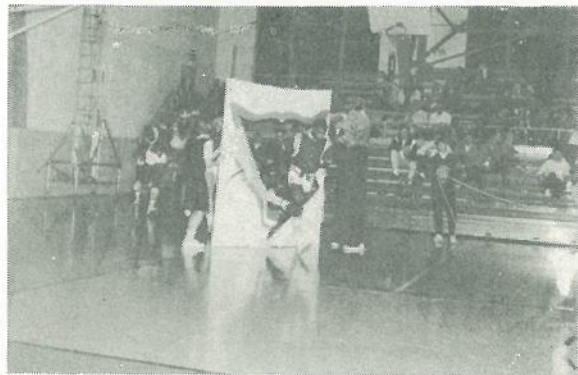
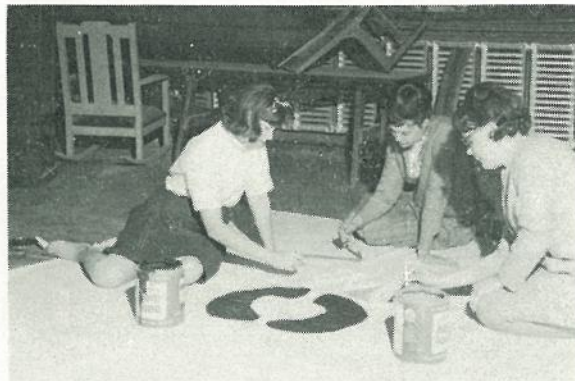
Since the beginning of school, the members of Central's Pep Club have spent many hours for the sake of promoting school spirit.

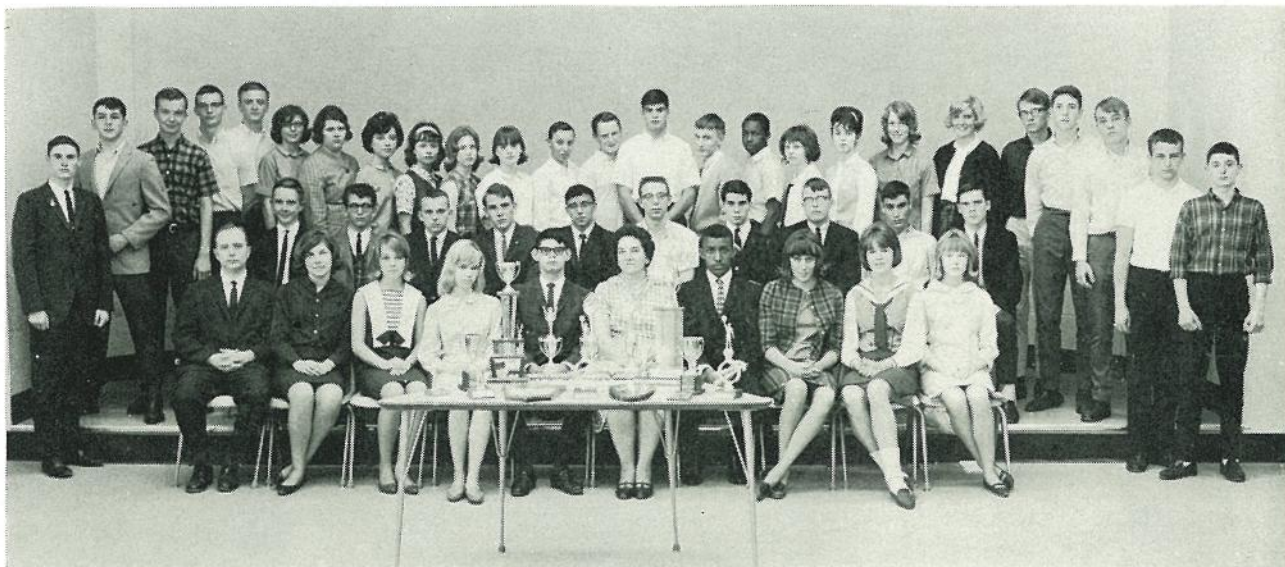
Logical Thinking Accompanies Every Debater

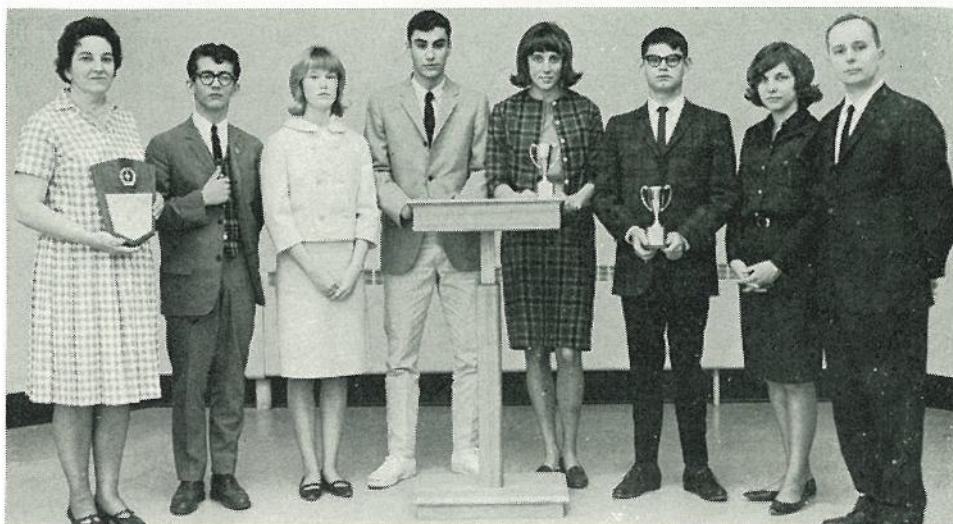

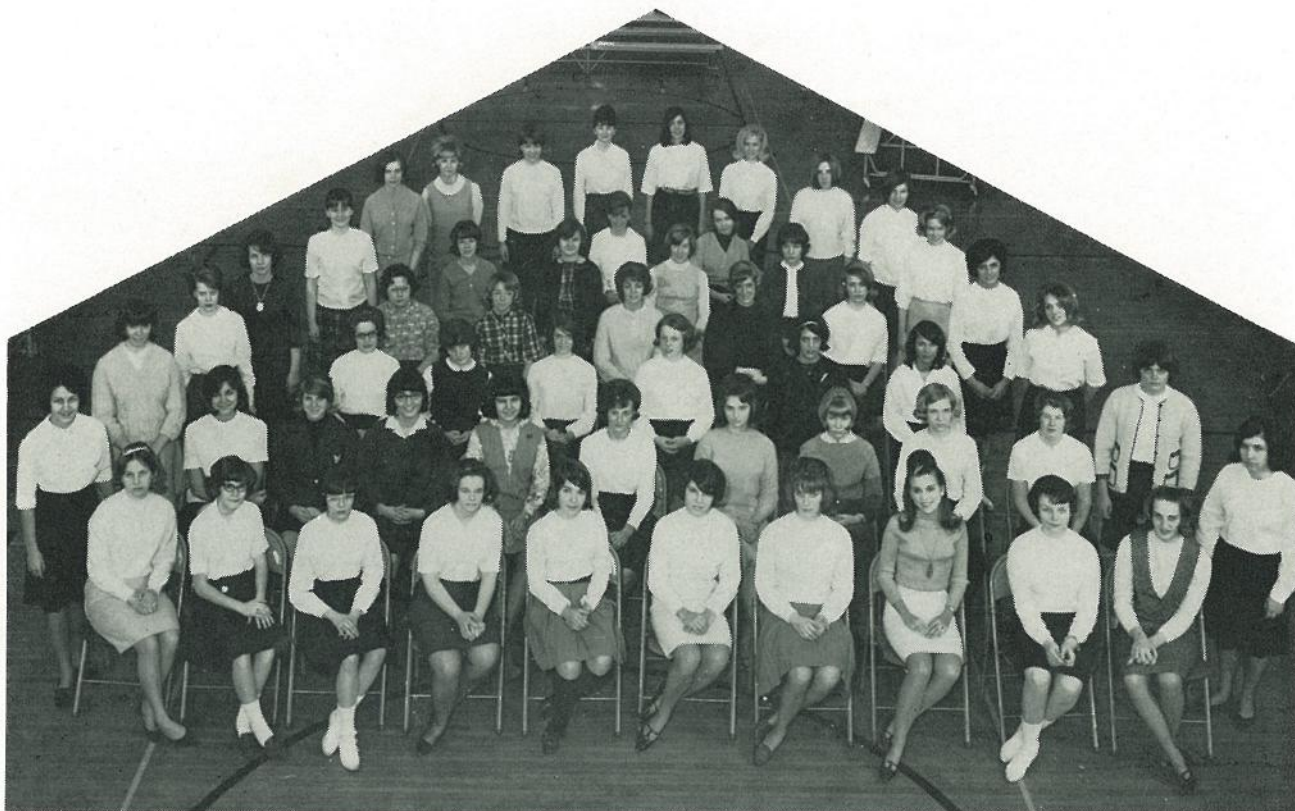

The leads were well supported by the rest of the cast, and the entire play was directed by Mr. Kenneth Peck with theatrical knowledge and skill.

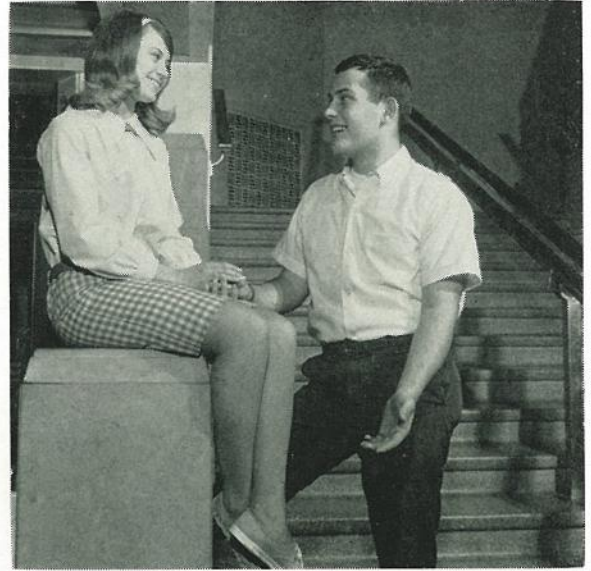

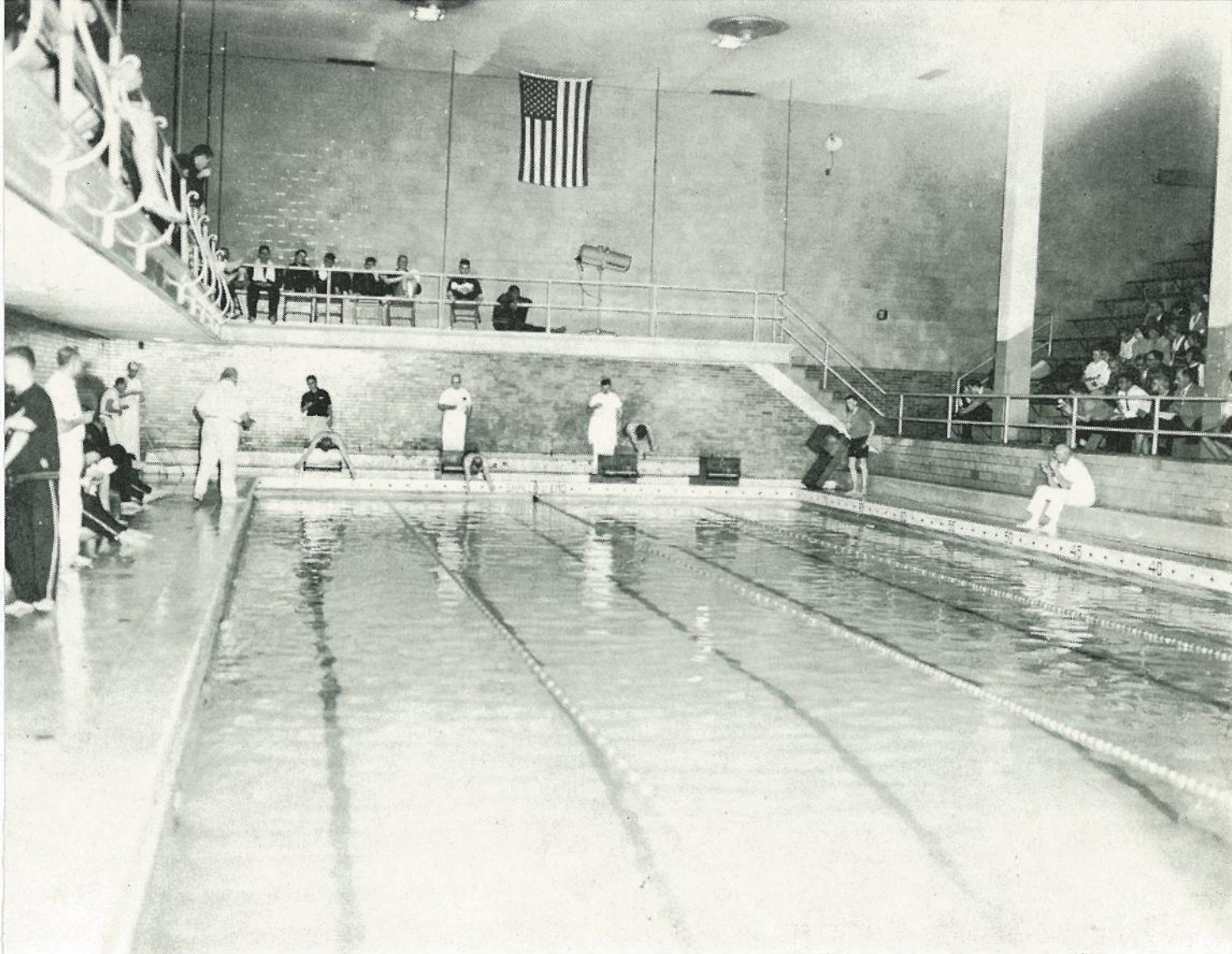
Little Bearcats Pave Way to Varsity Success

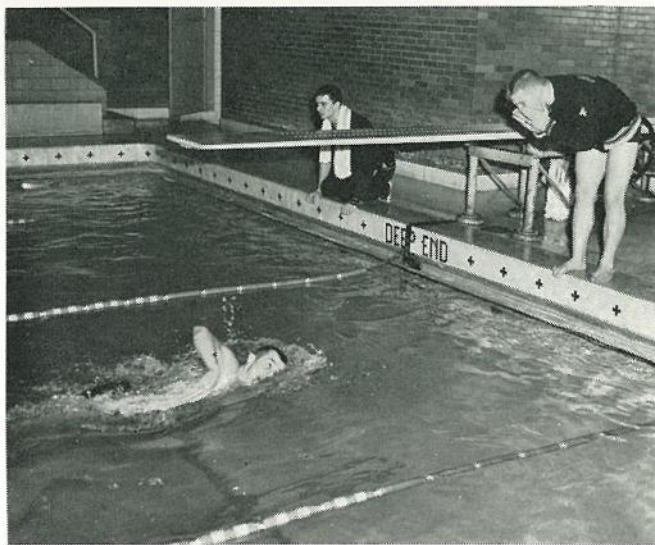
Tankers Never Taste Defeat

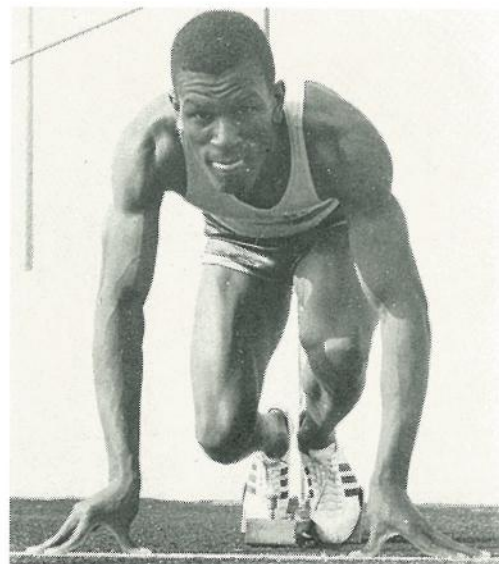

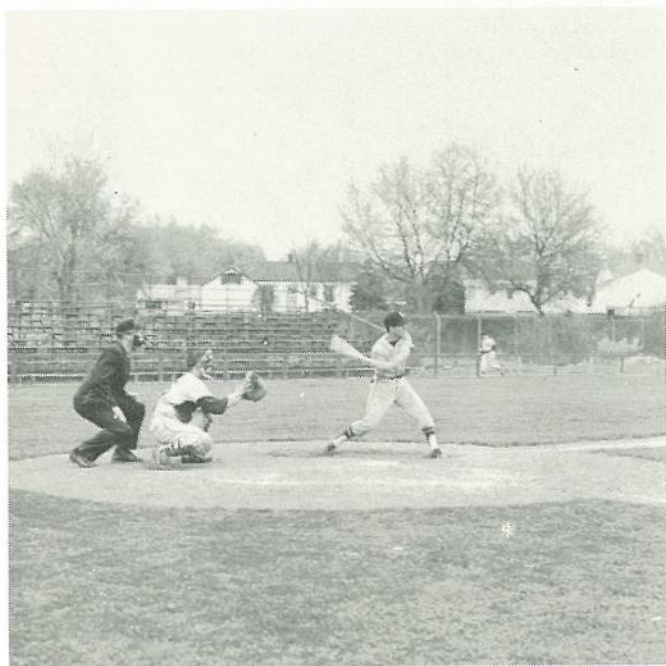
Baseball Team Is Experienced and Skillful

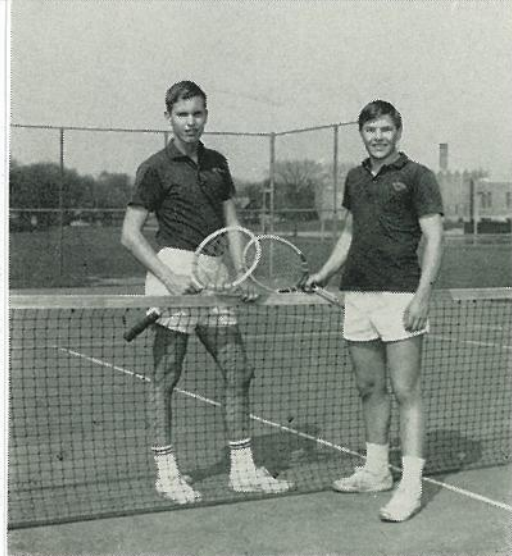

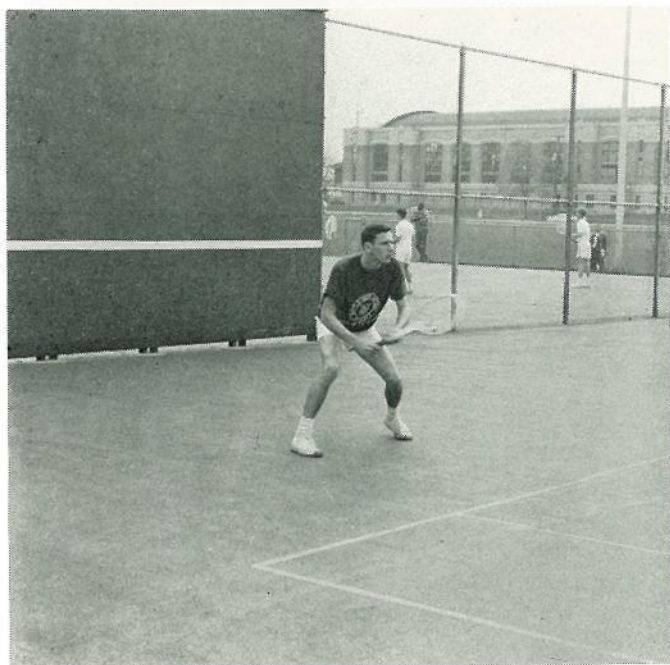
The '65 tennis team has improved greatly over the past few years. This season a large number turned out for practice, giving coach Jerry Miller a good selection.
